Welcome Fr. Godfred Boachie-Yiadom Sept. 5 & 6

Each year a missionary visits St. Teresa Parish to share how God is working in different parts of the world. This year we have Fr. Godfred from the Diocese of Obuasi, Ghana in Africa. The Diocese has 1,800,000 people, of which 101,000 are Catholics. Donations in the 2nd collection will support (1) the education of Seminarians and Catechists for the people, who are among the poorest in Africa; (2) creation of potable water for 23 villages through the sinking of wells; (3) medical care for buruli ulcer patients in 3 medical centers; (4) fund educational centers for children in the diocese.
