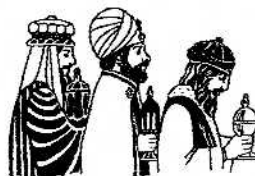
The St. Teresa Prayer Chain

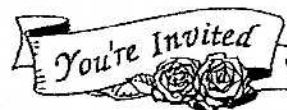
